

R. Wingate proposed a policy that all who attend Café must write a brief report sharing what attendees learned while there. K. Nystrom suggested that FCC have a table at Café that would provide a visible District 15 presence. Last year there were many attendees from District 15 who did not know about FCC. The table would be a meeting place and information center for FCC at Café. It would be community resource buffet and a recruiting station.
